The SIAM CSE21 BE program will provide scientific training, mentoring, and career and professional development to students who aspire to broaden their experience in research based professional activities. The program applies proven methods of engaging people from underrepresented communities in *mainstream* scientific and engineering societies. Program attendees will be recruited from populations traditionally underrepresented: women, under-represented minorities, first-generation students, and people with disabilities. The program will increase the participation in a major technical conference by people traditionally underrepresented in the field and provide important and meaningful mentoring and professional development opportunities.

The program also works to catalyze change in the community to create a more inclusive and diverse society by providing opportunities for scientists to:

- Get involved as a volunteer
- Learn how to create a more inclusive and diverse society
- Become an advocate
